**Venue:**

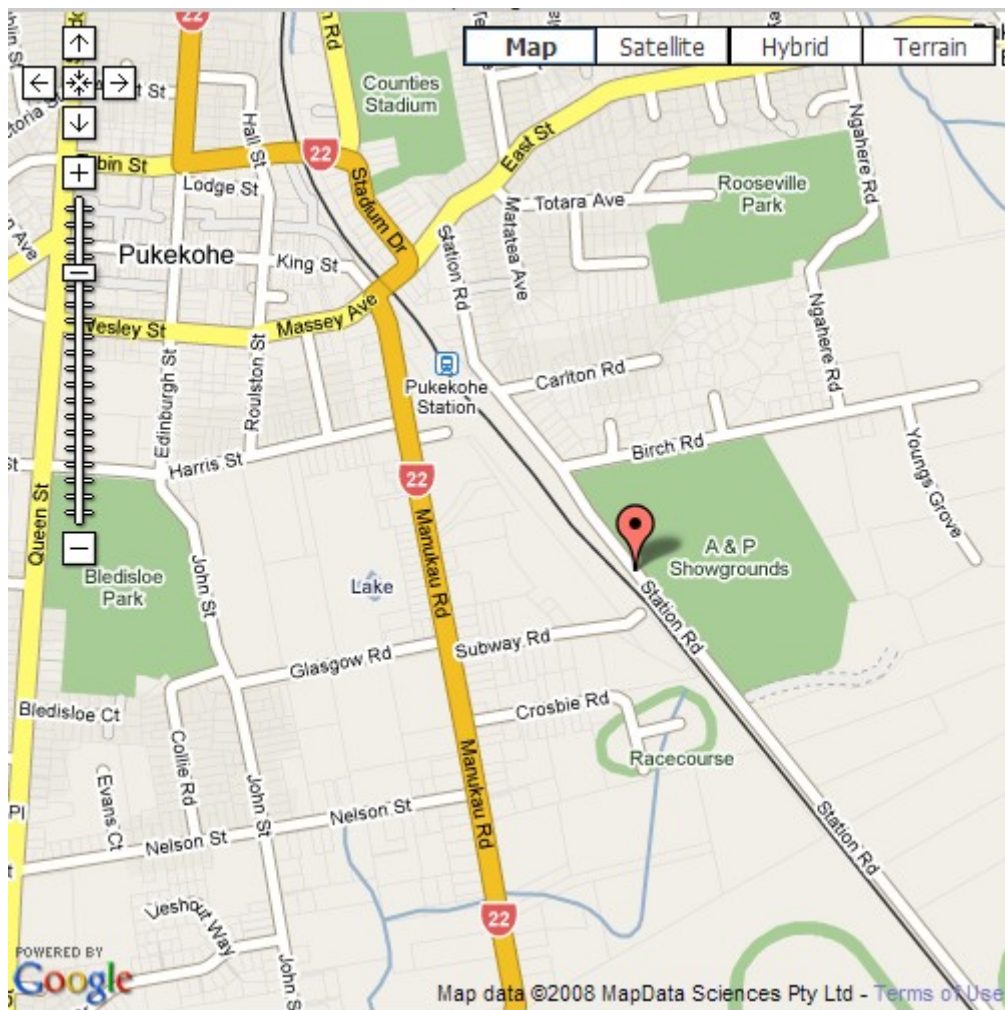

**Directions:**

Take the Bombay/Pukekohe East turnoff from SH1 and if travelling from the north, turn right at end of the off-ramp. If travelling from the south, turn left. You should go past the BP service station.

Stay on that road (Mill Rd which joins Pukekohe East Rd). After a time you should pass a motor lodge on your right then start climbing a hill. On the other side of the hill, turn down Station Road on the left. If you get to the Pukekohe East Road t-junction on the other side of the hill, you have gone too far.

Drive down Station Road and the track is situated at the end of the gravelled area on the left, opposite a rail over bridge.



**Rain Day:**

There is no rain day scheduled for this event. Should the event be affected by rain then the NZRCA rules regarding rain affected meetings will be applied

**Stock Motors:**

Competitors will be required to supply their own stock motors as per the NZRCA Rulebook.

Scrutineering will be done by the NZRCA and motors will be tested using the NZRCA supplied motor tester.

**Eligibility:**

All drivers must hold a current NZRCA license and be a financial member of an affiliated club. It is the drivers responsibility to ensure they have their license and club membership card with them. Licenses will be checked at registration/scrutineering.

# Racing Rules

## **Lap-Counting System:**

An AMB transponder system will be used for lapcounting. Use of personal transponders is supported.

## **Grid Start Positions:**

Starting positions for the first qualifying heats will be drawn randomly. The start order for subsequent qualify heats will be determined by your finishing position of the previous heat.

Grid positions for all finals will be determined by your qualifying position.

## **Qualifying:**

There will be 3 heats of qualifying for every class. Your single best time will determine your qualifying position for the finals.

Qualifying heats will be run using a timed staggered start as per the new NZRCA rule.

## **Finals:**

Maximum 10 cars per heat. Three rounds for all mains where your best points over 2 rounds will determine your final result for the event.

Final heats will be run using a grid start. Your grid position will be the same for all final heats and is your qualifying position.

## **Marshalling:**

Competitors are required to marshal the race immediately following their own race, unless physically disabled or they are in back-to-back races. In these cases the competitor must appoint a substitute marshal and the race director must be advised before racing commences for the day.

No open-toe footwear is to be worn when marshalling. There should be no eating, smoking, talking on cell phones etc while you are marshalling.

Your undivided attention is required at all times while marshalling – marshal the races the same way you would want your car marshalled.

## **Scrutineering:**

NZRCA rules will be strictly adhered to. Please ensure your car/s comply with all aspects of the NZRCA rules before submitting them. The NZRCA's position is that the onus is on the driver to prove legality in the event of a dispute.

## **Frequencies:**

All competitors must have at least two legal frequencies for each car entered. In the event of a crystal clash in the final, the higher placed competitor after qualifying will have preference for available frequencies.

Please check your frequencies at the start of the day before racing commences and notify the lap-scoring official of any errors/omissions as soon as possible

**Suitable tires:**

Club members use a combination of Losi Step-Pins Goose bumps, depending on personal preference. Losi Step-Pins are the most popular.

**Power:**

Will be available to competitors but limited. The club has a limited number of power points but will endeavor to provide for as many competitors as possible. An air compressor will be available.

**Food:**

Available from 'The Warehouse Complex', approximately 5 minutes walk from the venue.

**Rubbish:**

Please take your rubbish with you at the end of the day. Any littering will make it harder for the club to hold further events.
