Eligibility: Drivers **must** hold an NZRCA licence **and** be a financial member of an affiliated club.

Any class with less than 5 entries will be cancelled and drivers notified.

- Rules:** The meeting will be conducted under the following current New Zealand Radio Control Car Association Rules:
NZRCA Rules dated 1 January 2010, **Dispensation has been granted on Some rules by the NZRCA detail listed below**
- Lap Counting:** Scoring will be by AMBrc. You must either provide a suitable mounting position for a transponder somewhere in your car or a personal transponder.
- Numbers:** Race numbers will be provided. Please remove or cover any numbers already on cars.
- Stock Motors:** Competitors are to supply own 540 stock motors as per NZRCA rule book dated 01/01/2010. A motor tester will be used to check legality of a random selection of stock motors.
- Drivers** All drivers are required to register at the transmitter pound On arrival at the track. Drivers must register if they wish to race.
- Scrutineering:** It is the driver's responsibility to ensure his/her car complies with NZRCA Rules and Specifications. Cars will be scrutineered before racing commences and the Chief Scrutineer will be available for any queries. All cars are to be placed in the scrutineering pound immediately after each race where they will be scrutineered and are not to be uplifted until the competitor has finished his/her marshalling to the end of the next race. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.
- Indoor Venue:** At the time of entry forms being released, there is no indoor venue, however CMR will try to secure such a venue just in case and will advertise this on rcracing.co.nz, rcracer.co.nz, and nzrca.co.nz websites
- Power:** **Limited** Power will be available at the track for competitors, please supply your own extension cords. If you have your own personal generator or 12v battery to power off, *please bring these as power can sometimes be limited*

QUALIFYING:

- All Classes:** There will be a **minimum** of 3 heats for every car and dependant on numbers we will run up to 5 heats of qualifying. Best **ONE** performance will determine you're final and grid position. Competitors will start qualifying on a staggered start system.

FINALS:

Maximum of 10 car finals

There will be 3 rounds of finals for every car. (Weather dependant)
Finals will be on point's allocations with 1 point for first to 10 points for 10th,
The person with the lowest score at the end of the finals will be the winner.
In the case of a tie, the person with the fastest time will be declared the Winner.

PLEASE NOTE!

The following dispensations have been approved by the NZRCA and CMR hopes that this will encourage more drivers to enter this event as this will be a great chance to test your cars under the new rules before the NZRCA On-Road Electric championships.

1. Mini Rules will be run under the new 2011 Mini Rules; these can be downloaded from the rcracing and rcracer websites under the forums for the events.
2. All weight limits for electric classes have been lowered as per 2011 rules
 - a. Mini = 1225g
 - b. Stock = 1425g
 - c. Super stock = 1425g
 - d. Touring modified = 1425g
 - e. Pro 10 = 1115
 - f. Pro 12 = 800g
 - g. Formula one = 1100g
3. Body rule will be as per the NZRCA 2010 rule, or the new 2011 rule, body's must conform to either the 2010 NZRCA rule or the current IFMAR body list, this list will also be posted on the forum.
4. Battery Rule will be as per the new 2011 rule, all classes will be allowed LIPO's, LiFe, NiCad or NIMH with no Mah Limit, new rule will be available for download for the Websites
